HKGCC Certificate of Business Identity

The business environment is constantly changing and the Covid-19 pandemic has accelerated the digitization of many businesses. Consequently, meeting new customers and suppliers face to face is no longer as simple as it once was. This has made it more difficult to build trust, and provided an opportunity for unscrupulous companies to take advantage of the situation, creating concerns for legitimate, honest companies when entering into agreements with new clients.

The Hong Kong General Chamber of Commerce's (HKGCC) Certificate of Business Identity (CBI) allows third parties to quickly and easily verify if they are dealing with a company legitimately registered in Hong Kong. The CBIs can be customized and in general certify:

- Business Registration Certificate
- Key Directors
- Business Address
- Business Nature
- Annual Turnover
- Employment Size
- Corporate Bank Account
- Tax Return
- Trademark
- License
- Quality Control
- Other Company Particulars

I hope that you can share this information with your respective trade departments so that in the event they require enquiries for help from business people in your country to verify a company in Hong Kong, then they may request the Hong Kong company concerned to apply for a CBI from HKGCC. Our ultimate goal is to promote trade and collaboration between your country and Hong Kong and minimize the risk of unscrupulous business practices.

For your information, HKGCC has been issuing Certificate of Origins since 1920. As the largest and oldest business documentation issuing organization in Hong Kong, we are internationally recognized.
